



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What courses are available?

Currently, one international post-graduate course is available i.e. MA in Music Therapy. Two further MAs, in Art Therapies and Curatorial Practice are being launched. FAQs apply to all international courses at FAA.

Q: What qualifications are required for the above courses?

- Bachelor's degree in respective field of study according to criteria of each course. For further information, please visit the webpage or contact FAA directly.
- English proficiency test certificate (attained within the previous two years): TOEFL paper-based score of at least 500 or IELTS (academic) score of at least 5.0 or CU-TEP score of at least 60.

Deadline of Application

A certificate of admission will be issued and sent to the applicant via email.

Students are required to present this certificate to the program of their choice when they register.

Application Fee

Applicants are required to include an application fee of THB 1,000 (plus 3% credit card processing fee), for each application they make. Credit card payment can be made by logging into an application account.

Cancellation Policy

There is NO refund for the cancellation fee for any program he/she has applied.
